Questions for Study and Reflection

1. How do we see that the church is the family of God in these passages?
2. How do we see the church as the dwelling place of God in these passages?
3. Why is it essential for believers to become more and more like Christ (the Cornerstone) in order to be the place of Gods dwelling? How is becoming more like Christ related to koinonia with God the Father?
4. How is it that your connection and life with other believers is related to your own personal fellowship with God?
5. Why is fellowship or koinonia more than simply spending time together with believers? What has to happen between believers in order to really experience koinonia?
6. What are some practical examples of the ways that we can come closer to God through our interaction with other believers?
7. How might an understanding of true koinonia begin to expand the way we think about evangelism?
